MySpace Is a Natural Monopoly



Economics teaches that the market for some goods and services are "natural" monopolies.





Result:

- Engagement rose 30%
- Utilitarian to aspirational
- Now 45% of users use Wish List feature



✓ Prioritize! Identify small areas of improvement that will have the greatest impact

✓ Look for ways to experiment and test your assumptions.



- Encourage employees to come forth with better solutions to try, and test them.
 - ✓ Ask your team the question every week: is there a process that can be improved?



- 1. What is the problem you're solving and how can you make it better?
- 2. What are you going to do next week to keep learning?
- 3. What small experiment can you propose to your team in June?
